New edition of the “Trommel Genealogy”

The answers are recorded in the Trommel Genealogy, first printed in 1976 by J.G. Trommel (1932-2005). Sold out for 30 years, we (eldest son of the author and a distant nephew) decided to prepare a new edition and updates in the future. As of now, the new edition in PDF format is downloadable via our website free of charge. Because of privacy laws, there are two versions available:

- **Public version**
This public version is available free of charge to anyone interested. It has no photographs and contains, for privacy reasons, only details of deceased people. One can distribute this public version freely for non-commercial purposes. In due time, the omitted photographs and other illustrations will be made available through our website as supplements.
- **Confidential version**
To be able to download the confidential version, which is almost identical to the 1976 issue, registration is required, which is for family members only. Please visit the website for more details.

New publications

In the nearby future, we hope to update the original version of the Trommel Genealogy. Our aim is to increase the amount of old photographs, illustrations, anecdotes, historical backgrounds and family trees to provide greater insight. Again, for privacy reasons, these will also be available in two versions.

Please consider: Current genealogical information about your part of the family, entertaining anecdotes, scanned family photos, family documents et cetera.
